We're Rounding, Rounding, Rounding in Math Class! We are working on rounding to the nearest 10's, 100's, and even 1000's. One way we're remembering, is identifying the "Target" number, and then looking directly at the number to the right:

"If it's four or less - let it rest. If it's five or more - raise the score."

Also placing numbers on a number line or "mountain" is a helpful visual to show where a value lands between two round numbers (10 or 20, 100 or 200, or 1000 or 2000.)
