Mrs Cleveland's MATH Class:

Grade 4 has just wrapped up Part 1 of 2 of Data Management. We investigated graphs, charts, infographics, and stem and leaf plots. We will be circling back soon in the next while to dive into "central tendencies" also known as Mean, Median, and Mode.

This week we go full speed ahead in computation! Adding and Subtracting decimal numbers in the 100th with regrouping, as well as multiplication of 2 by 1, and 2 by 2 digits and (even greater for a challenge). Students will be having more frequent quizzes in this unit as practice is key. Students will be starting a Market Math assignment which will be mostly completed during class. We will also get into more "problem solving" challenges including how proper read a question, sifting through the provided information to choose what parts are required, and focus on key terms and strategies to try out a possible plan! It's okay if students don't get it right away- the process here is more important than only the sole product.

This Thursday, we will also have a special "Love of Math" activity, during our double math period to celebrate "Pi Day!"

Ms.M's Class:
